Dr. Twine is an assistant professor at the University of Minnesota. She attended the Pennsylvania State University where she received a B.S. in meteorology. Dr. Twine then worked for two years at NASA Goddard Space Flight Center in Greenbelt, Maryland before attending graduate school at the University of Wisconsin where she earned an M.S. and Ph.D. in atmospheric and oceanic sciences. After spending 3 ½ years in the Department of Atmospheric Sciences at the University of Illinois, she joined the Department of Soil, Water, and Climate at the University of Minnesota in January 2008.

She is most interested in the part of the atmosphere in which we live—right at Earth's surface. The exchanges of energy, carbon, and water are so important for the welfare of ecosystems, yet their complexities make them difficult to quantify, and even more difficult to predict how they might change in the future.
